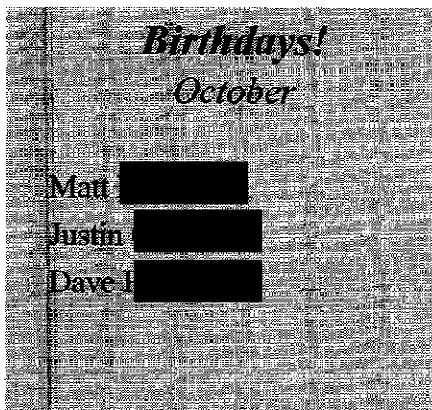
Attention Parents/Guardian *and* Scouts!!
